# Cousin Marriage (from Wiki)

Today, more than 10% of all marriages are cousin marriages\*.

Due to the benefits of these marriages, they are actively encouraged and sought out in many cultures. Benefits: 1) keep cultural values intact, 2) preserve family wealth, 3) maintain geographic proximity, 4) keep tradition, 5) strengthen family ties, and 6) maintain family structure or a closer relationship between the wife and her in-laws.

# Cousin Marriage (from Wiki)

Today, more than 10% of all marriages are cousin marriages\*.


# Cousin Marriage (from Wiki)

Cousin marriage has been allowed throughout the Middle East for all recorded history. Some Anthropologists view it as the defining feature of the Middle Eastern kinship system. In some cities, 70% of marriages were cousin marriages.

Across the Western world, cousin marriages declined in the 19th C as women gained more independence and arranged marriages decreased. At one point, the Catholic Church banned marriages within the 4th degree.


