



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## Chapter 9: Renewed Covenant

- God-human-(ALL) creation

  - This is the first repetition of God making a promise (Gideon)

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Some, as early as the classical Midrash, have glimpsed here a Zeus-Chronos story in which the son castrates the father or, alternately, penetrates him sexually. The latter possibility is reinforced by the fact that "to see the nakedness of" frequently means "to copulate with," it is noteworthy that the Hebrews associated the Canaanites with lasciviousness (see, for example, the rape of Dinah, Genesis 34).

- It is "racist" propaganda just like Lot's daughters with Moad and Esau with Edom.
- This story has been abused to enslave millions of people of color and was often quoted by slave owners.
